Eligibility Requirements to Become an AGBU Religious Study Fellow

AGBU offers scholarships to full-time graduate students of Armenian descent worldwide (excluding citizens of Armenia studying in Armenia) who are pursuing Religious Studies (priesthood and youth ministry).

Grants are available for up to three (3) years of graduate study.

Applicants must be enrolled in highly competitive colleges and universities in or outside of the United States with a GPA of 3.0 and above, as measured by the American grading system scale.

Applicants who are citizens of Armenia qualify for grants for study outside of Armenia only if a major portion of the tuition and other expenses - 75 percent or more - has already been secured through foundations, governmental and state grants, and/or the academic institution they are attending.

The deadline for returning a completed application is **May 15**.

Incomplete applications or those postmarked after May 15 will not be considered.

Complete applications will undergo a selective review process based on the following criteria:

- o Academic Excellence
- o Financial Need
- o Prior Public and Community Service, with particular attention to their involvement in the Armenian church and community

Scholarships are awarded annually in the range of \$1,000-5,000.

AGBU Religious Study Fellows will be announced by the end of August.



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APPLICATION CHECKLIST

- Completed application form (in English or Armenian)
- Two letters of recommendation (in English or Armenian):
 - A reference describing your academic and/or professional progress, with particular attention to your chosen field of study
 - A reference describing prior/current public and community service, with particular attention to your involvement in the Armenian community
- Most recent transcript of grades. **This document must be in English or translated into English.**
- Enrollment verification or acceptance letter of the institution you plan to attend in the Fall of 2010. **This document must be in English or translated into English.**
- A copy of the Bursar's receipt from the institution that you plan or are considering to attend in the fall of 2010. **This document must be in English or translated into English.**
- A copy of the Financial Award Letter from the institution that you plan or are considering to attend in the fall of 2010. **This document must be in English or translated into English.**
- A copy of your 2009 filed Federal Tax Return (form 1040). *You may also submit a written letter of intent to file and submit a copy of your tax return once it has been filed.* **This requirement applies only to residents of the U.S.**
- Your current resume
- One passport-size photograph

The deadline for returning a completed application is **May 15**.
